What does Deuteronomy 6:7, 11:19, Proverbs 22:6 and 2 Timothy 3:14-15 outline as the role of parents and adults when it comes reaching children with the truth of God?

How does Matthew 18:6 and Ephesians 6:4 warn us how serious God is about kids knowing the truth of the Gospel? How do we sometimes allow this to happen?

Psalm 8:2 is very specific on what children should do. How is this different than the technology saturated world they are growing up in. How can we help children do what this passage teaches us?

Read Matthew 21:15-16 and talk about what the children were doing and how that not only changes the children, but, how it changes the world.
