Ruling Elders are responsible for the oversight of the church (Acts 20:28). They are to watch over the spiritual welfare of the congregation (1 Pt 5:2). Ruling Elders should study and grow in the Word and become equipped to teach the Word (2 Tim 3:16). They provide pastoral care by visiting the sick, the bereaved, the lonely, the aged, and the shut-in. Elders, as they live in the very atmosphere of prayer, are to see to the spiritual development of the congregation (2 Cor. 1:10, 11). They also connect with the people of the church in the chamber of the sick and the dying; in conversing with the anxious inquirer, and the perplexed or struggling believer.

In the Old Testament, the office of Elder was established for the oversight of the Church. In the New Testament, this office is continued. Those who fill this office today for governing the Church are called Ruling Elders. Chosen by the people of a particular congregation, these Ruling Elders are to watch over the spiritual welfare of that congregation. When appointed to participate in Presbytery or General Assembly, they shall watch over the spiritual welfare and participate diligently in the workings of that portion of the Church to which they are commissioned, recognizing that the Evangelical Presbyterian Church is a connectional church. The Ruling Elder shares authority with the Teaching Elder (Pastor Jeff) in all of the courts of the church, in both rights and duties. As a representative of the people, it is the first duty of the Ruling Elder to represent the mind of Christ, as that person understands it, in the various courts of the Church.

#### A scriptural thought from Pastor Rick Warren as we reflect that 3tc has been learning what it is to be "All In"...

"Here's the key question: How badly do you want God's blessing in your life? Will you trust him with everything and choose to follow his commands, no matter what?

If you live God's way and if you give God's way, you can expect him to multiply your seed of generosity: "He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness" (2 Corinthians 9:10 NIV).

You need to expect God to multiply your seed. Giving is not a debt you owe. It's a seed you sow. And when you let go of what God has already placed in your hand (because he put it there in the first place), God will replace it with much more.

Five times in Scripture, Jesus commands us not to store up wealth on earth but to store it up in heaven. How do you do that? By giving and planting the seeds of generosity.

When you do that, God will use your giving to reap generosity in others. They will see that you trust God in all things, and they will be blessed. That blessing will reap a harvest that God can multiply for his kingdom in ways you could never imagine."




### Inside Inspiration...

Jesus values children. At Three Timbers Church, we believe it's vital to teach children about the love of Jesus Christ. Our Children's Ministry is designed to do just that.

Our children begin the service with their families for worship through song. Then the children in kindergarten through fifth grade go to their own "Children's Worship Service" where they worship God through active songs, give in an offering, learn from Bible lessons for kids and enjoy reinforcement activities and fun games to build friendships. Our preschool children go to their own Sunday school class where they learn from the Bible as well as through games and songs that help them understand their Bible lesson. Our nursery is open throughout the service, where even our little ones learn from the Bible and are sung to and prayed for.

We believe in partnering with parents to train children in the way they should go while they are young so that when they are old they will not depart from it (Proverbs 22:6). Our goal is to partner with parents by providing a worship service for the children so that our kids know how to apply the Bible lesson that they learned and that church is for them, that God loves them and wants a relationship with them, and that church is super fun!














#### **BRANCHES ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS**

we offer an annual mission trip in the summer.








### CONNECT! ~ Adult Ministries



#### How has your faith and/or three timbers church impacted your life?

"Growing up in the church and attending a Baptist university gave me the basic foundations for my faith. However, looking back, the strength of my faith has really matured over the past ten years and especially with the planting of three timbers church.



I went from going to church on Sundays and believing in God, to having a relationship with Jesus every day and trusting God's plan for my life even when it didn't make sense or didn't seem fair.

I went from trying to be in control of my life and independent, to turning to God and surrendering to him. I went from trying to make what I wanted to do fit in God's plan, to asking what God's plan is and then trying to figure out what he wants me to do.

This trust in God has been freeing and energizing. When I struggle, I can turn it over to God to deal with; it's not up to me to solve.

When we first talked about planting a church, that was a big and daunting undertaking and not one I was sure I wanted to do. But I remember Jeff saying something about being a part of something so big it would surely fail without God and won't it be amazing to see what God does.

I'm glad we went all in. Time and again God comes through and shows me how big He is. My faith brings peace and happiness to my life and reminds me that God is good, all the time."
